

ERICSSON MOBILITY REPORT: MORE THAN HALF A BILLION 5G SUBSCRIPTIONS BY THE END OF 2021



Ericsson (NASDAQ: ERIC) projects that 5G mobile subscriptions will exceed 580 million by the end of 2021, driven by an estimated one million new 5G mobile subscriptions every day.

The forecast, which features in the <u>twentieth</u> <u>edition of the Ericsson Mobility Report</u>, enhances the expectation that 5G will become the fastest adopted mobile generation. About 3.5 billion 5G subscriptions and 60 percent 5G population coverage are forecast by the end of 2026.

However, the pace of adoption varies widely by region. Europe is off to a slower start and has


continued to fall far behind China, the U.S., Korea, Japan and the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) markets in the pace of 5G deployments.

5G is expected to surpass a billion subscriptions two years ahead of the 4G LTE timeline for the same milestone. More than $300\,5G$ smartphone models have already been announced or launched commercially.

This commercial 5G momentum is expected to continue in coming years, spurred by the enhanced role of connectivity as a key component of post-COVID-19 economic recovery.





Metito has been keen to protect the environment and take sustainability into account, so the project was designed to consume the least amount of energy per cubic meter of produced water, which will positively affect the economics of operation and reduce the carbon footprint of the project by employing advanced methods to recover energy from wastewater (i.e., highly saline concentrated water).


